REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS

Students are invited to apply for participation in the portfolio management team of the Salant Student Investment Program, which was established by a generous gift from Johns Hopkins alumnus Marshal L. Salant. Applicants must be full-time undergraduate students at Hopkins.

The program provides Hopkins undergraduate students from the Whiting School of Engineering and the Krieger School of Arts & Sciences the opportunity to make actual investment decisions in managing a portfolio. By participating in this investment program, students will receive a unique business experience that will enhance their career opportunities. The program is organized as an extracurricular activity and no credit is granted for participation.

A portion of any profits earned by the portfolio will be dedicated to providing scholarship support for undergraduate students in the Schools of Engineering and Arts & Sciences.

Ten to fifteen students, representing all classes, will be selected to manage the investment portfolio, with terms ending May 31, 2009. Approximately three to six students from each class will be chosen for the team. Three team members will be appointed to form an executive committee.

To apply, students must submit:

- Resume
- Transcript (please get an *unofficial* copy from the registrar)
- Cover letter describing your interest in the field of financial services
- Deadline: **FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 29, 2008 (5pm)**

Selection will be based on course background, work experience, and merit. **Students do not need investment or financial services experience to apply and be considered.** Top candidates will be interviewed in March, with final selections for the management team and executive committee to be announced shortly thereafter.
