The Howard Hughes Medical Institute has invited Johns Hopkins to submit nominations for the *International Student Research Fellowship*. Launched in 2011, this is a three-year fellowship awarded to second or third year students who are engaged in doctoral dissertation work. The official announcement provides specific details about the program. Prospective applicants should be international graduate students in the biomedical sciences. Eligible fields of study include biology, chemistry, physics, math, computer science, engineering, and plant biology – as well as interdisciplinary research.

## Eligibility & Requirements:

- Are **not** U.S. citizens, non-citizen nationals, or permanent residents of the U.S.
- Demonstrate exceptional talent for research
- Are affiliated with a laboratory in which they will conduct their dissertation research
- Invited students must be in the second or third year of a PhD program in the biomedical or related sciences at a designated nominating institution to activate the fellowship

## Internal Nomination Process:

JHU Applicants should use the [JHU-JHMI internal application form](#) and follow the instructions regarding required documents. The deadline to submit preliminary applications for internal review is **Monday, October 26, 2015.**

Eligible candidates should submit their materials in sequence in one PDF document to [tracysmith@jhu.edu](mailto:tracysmith@jhu.edu). If references are being sent separately, please include the candidates name in the subject line to assure matching with the application. Each applicant/referee should expect to receive an email confirming receipt of their materials within three (3) business days.
