360.528 Applied Economics Research

This is a research course with an internship component. The internship component is given in conjunction with private businesses and financial institutions, governmental entities, and economic research institutes.

Prerequisites: 180.101-102 Elements of Macroeconomics, Elements of Microeconomics

Credits: 3 hours, Graded

Limit: 10 Students

Requirements:

1. Student must obtain an internship prior to obtaining Prof. Hanke's permission to register for the course. Prof. Hanke must approve the internship. To register, the student must bring a completed gold Independent Study / Research / Internship form and an Add / Drop slip to Prof. Hanke for his signature.
2. Student must provide employer with 120 hours of unpaid service.
3. Student must provide Prof. Hanke with a written statement from his / her employer that he / she has completed #2.
4. Student must maintain a brief weekly log of his/ her activities.
5. Student must write a research paper on an approved topic related to the student's internship (minimum 15 pages double-spaced). The topic of the research paper must be approved by Prof. Hanke. The research paper must be fully documented with proper citations from scholarly literature. Topics such as "what I did on my summer vacation (internship)" are inappropriate and will not be approved.
6. Items 3, 4 and 5 must be submitted to Professor Hanke no later than the last day of the reading period. Failure to submit all items on time will result in an **automatic grade of "F."**
