Jana Hranaiova is a Senior Financial Economist at the Public Company Accounting Oversight Board, (PCAOB), where her primary responsibility is to build quantitative models that help inspectors identify potential audit failures. PCAOB is a non-profit organization established by Sarbanes-Oxley in 2002 to oversee audit firms. Jana Hranaiova is also a visiting professor at JHU and GWU, teaching courses in Financial Derivatives and Applied Econometrics. Before joining PCAOB, she worked at CFTC(Commodities Futures Trading Commission) in the Office of the Chief Economist conducting research on derivatives markets. She got her PhD in Finance and Applied Economics from Cornell University and her Master's from Penn State University.
